Working with Zoom in Universal Access

Zoom is a feature that is part of Universal Access. It is part of a series of tools that were designed for special needs individuals, but is a great presentation support as well. To begin working with Zoom it must first be enabled.

- 1. Open System Preferences (Apple Menu / System Preferences)
- 2. Select Universal Access in the System row




3. Select the "Seeing" button.

4. Click the On radio button under Zoom to toggle the feature on, and then click Options to select specific features.

5. In the bottom section, click the radio button next to "Only when the pointer reaches an edge.



- 6. Click Done.
- 7. Close the Universal Access window using the red close button.
- 8. To use the Zoom feature, hold down the Apple (Command) and Option keys with the +. Zoom into the desired level.
- 9. Zoom out by using the key combination Apple (Command) / Option / (minus)
